## • Spring tidy

Can you spare an hour or few to spruce up the club? You are invited to volunteer for the following jobs in & around the club:

- Decorate the main clubhouse room,
- Paint the storeroom & the main doors,
- Repair & paint the fascia & soffit by court 4,
- Wash &/or paint white boarded under hang to the front entrance,
- Jetwash & re-paint if necessary front elevation,
- Repair or replace hinge to electricity cupboard,



- Stain benches by the clubhouse.

In addition,

- A scheduled major clean of courts 1 & 2 is being planned. Members will be kept informed of any necessary court closures.
- The committee is aware of the light issue on court 5. This will be addressed in late summer, when other lights are also likely to require attention in order to make best use of the hiring of machinery.
- Gazebo project: we have a working group & they will consult with members as plans develop.
- Club cleaning Glen is employed by the club and works approximately 2 hours per week. Whilst he does undertake some cleaning indoors, please do ensure that you clean up after yourselves and leave the clubhouse as you would wish to find it, including wiping down surfaces and emptying bins if they are full.

**Light use.** Please make an extra effort to turn only the essential lights on for play. Courts 1 & 2 have energy efficient LED bulbs and can be switched on individually, so please use these in preference when possible. Similarly, consider when clubhouse indoor & outdoor lights can be switched off when the clubhouse is not in use.

Remember that court lights must be switched off by 9:30pm with no exceptions and are not to be used at all on Sundays.

### Emergency access to the club

In the event of emergency vehicles requiring access to the clubhouse or courts, they need directing through the wooden gate to the side of the Scout Hut at the far end of the Village Hall carpark, over the playing fields round the back of the village hall. The code for the wooden gate padlock is indicated on the Emergency Access sign on the top left of the main noticeboard in the clubhouse.

Also, at the top left of the same notice board in the clubhouse, there is a labelled key on a hook to open the padlock on the gate of court 5 adjacent to the playing field if required.

Next time you are in the clubhouse, please do familiarise yourself with this procedure & locate the sign, code and key.

A 1<sup>st</sup> Aid kit is in the clubhouse & if needed, please do complete the accident book. The nearest AED (Defibrillator) is located outside the main door of the Village Hall. You will need to get a code to open the box by dialling 999, so take a phone with you.
