Club maintenance and development

1. Improving our Facilities; project update

Further to the club's successful application and the generous £20, 000 donation from the assets of the former Beach Tennis Club, together with our own match-funding, progress is as follows:

- A quote has now been accepted for the supply and construction of a 6m x 4m oak frame gazebo with a pitched, tiled roof and an Indian stone base. Planning permission is required & this is now moving forward. Please continue to be patient as this may take a few months!
- Energy-efficient LED lights will be fitted to replace the existing lighting on courts 3 & 4 and this order has now been placed.
- The shed will be replaced with a larger version, which will provide increased necessary storage for maintenance equipment.
- 2. New benches.

Club member, Heather McBride has generously made 2 benches, the materials for which have been sponsored by two committee members. Ideally two more benches would mean all court-benches are in good order. If any member would like to sponsor one, the cost is £60. Please contact Bob Floyd on 07969 185 839 if you are interested.

3. Court Maintenance.

Our courts suffer being so close to trees as leaves, twigs, acorns etc. clog up the carpet. A deep clean is being arranged for courts 1 & 2.

An improved court-cleaning schedule is now in place and alongside this, members are asked to please play their part:

Each pair of courts will soon have a drag-mat, bin, brush and shovel. Please use the drag-mats to clear any debris before play and use the brush and shovel to remove the waste collected.

The drag-mats also agitate the carpet, which in turn helps prevent moss and algae forming. Even when free of debris, use of the drag-mat each day will be beneficial.



Regular groups playing each weekday morning and junior coaching on Saturdays are now asked to please establish a new routine of dragging the courts and surrounds; probably a 10-minute job per pair of courts each day.

Floodlight use

Please make an extra effort to turn only the essential lights on for play. Courts 1 & 2 have energy efficient LED bulbs and can be switched on individually, so please use these in preference when possible. Similarly, consider when clubhouse indoor & outdoor lights can be switched off when the clubhouse is not in use.

Remember that court lights must be switched off by 9:30pm with no exceptions and are not to be used at all on Sundays.

We are also in discussion to plan the next safeguarding visit from the LTA, which will coincide with a questionnaire being circulated for members by email, which you are asked to please complete & return in order to provide feedback and effect any necessary changes.
