POLICY ON THE USE OF CLUBHOUSE TOILETS FOR CHANGING

Cuddington & Sandiway Tennis Club strives to ensure that all children are safeguarded from abuse and have an enjoyable tennis experience.

This document sets out the Cuddington & Sandiway Tennis Club policy for the use of our two unisex toilets within the clubhouse. The toilet cubicles are of generous size, enclosed with lockable doors and may be used by an individual as a changing facility. There are no shower facilities.

- 1. Toilet cubicles are accessible for use by an individual child or adult at any one time, with the exception of when a parent/carer is required to assist their own child.
- 2. For younger children, their parent / carer is responsible for their own child. If it is likely that a child will require assistance, parent/carers who best-know their child and have primary responsibility for their welfare are expected to remain in club grounds & be available to assist their child in the toilet facility as and when required. Club coaching staff / volunteers / other members cannot be expected to assist a child within the toilet cubicles.
- 3. Groups of children or adults will not use the toilets as changing facilities (with the exception of a household group if required) and under no circumstances will adult staff, coaches or volunteers change at the same time as a child in the same cubicle.
- 4. Club members are required to comply with all other existing club rules/policies which relate to behaviour within and use of club facilities.
